## Introduction

#### **About CARY Base**

CARY Base is a calendar clock for persons who need extra help to keep track of the day and to remember things. The screen shows the date, day of the week, time and whether it is morning, day, evening or night. You can have the information read out by tapping the screen or by using a control switch.

It is possible to show the user's daily activities on the display and to give personal reminders on desired times. The calendar is administrated directly on the device or remotely through the web service myAbilia.

To suit the user's needs, the amount of information on the display can be reduced and the language can be set to one of the many available languages.

## Intended purpose

CARY Base is a calendar clock that is intended to provide support for persons who have deficiencies in time orientation and memory.


CARY Base is intended for indoor use in a home environment.

## Get started with CARY Base

#### Place CARY Base in the home

Decide where to place CARY Base in the home. Place it where it is easily seen, like on the kitchen counter. Make sure that there are no reflections from any lights or windows on the display.



#### Start CARY Base



**WARNING:** Only use the power adapter that is supplied with CARY Base.





1. Connect the contact to the Power jack, marked with ♥.

2. Connect the Power adapter to a power outlet.

## Set up CARY Base

Upon starting CARY Base for the first time, you are guided to set your preferred language, date and time. If you want, you can also change the information that is displayed on the screen.

For more information, see Change the settings on page 9.

## **Use CARY Base**

#### Use the Main view

- See today's date and time on the display.
- See today's activities.
   This is only available when the Day plan is enabled in the settings.
- Tap on the display to hear the displayed information.



This is only available when your chosen language has speech support and speech support is enabled in the settings.

#### **Use Reminders**

A reminder is shown when the activity starts. If you do not close the reminder yourself, it closes automatically after 30 minutes.

- Tap anywhere on the display to stop the reminder signal.
- Tap Play to repeat the reminder message.
- · Tap OK to close the reminder.

## Change the speech support volume

Change the speech support volume through the + and - buttons on the side of CARY Base.



## Day intervals

CARY Base displays the part of the day according to day intervals. The day intervals can be changed, see *Change the settings* on page 9.

The day intervals are pre-programmed as follows:

Early morning: 06:00–09:00
Mid-morning: 09:00–12:00
Afternoon: 12:00–18:00
Evening: 18:00–23:00
Night: 23:00–06:00


During the night hours, the display brightness is reduced automatically. If Dark background is on, the color of the background is dark during the night hours.

**TIP:** You can turn off the display by pressing the power button. The display lights up for reminders.

## **Customise CARY Base**

#### Go to the Power menu

The Power menu gives you access to the Settings and the Calendar. You can also turn off CARY Base from this menu.






1. Press and hold the power button. 2. The Power menu opens.

## Change the settings

To change the settings of CARY Base, go to the Power menu and tap ②.





#### Language

Select a language.

Languages marked with 
have speech support.



#### Time and date

Set the date and time.



#### Display

See Choose the display information on page 10.



#### Day and night

Change the day intervals, set the display brightness, and turn on Dark background.

**EXAMPLE:** Set the start time for morning to your usual wakeup time.



#### Sound

Adapt the speech support and the reminder signal.



## Internet (optional)

Connect to the Internet to:

- Automatically get the date and time.
- · Use myAbilia.



## myAbilia (optional)

Update the calendar remotely, see *Remote* support through myAbilia on page 13.



## Choose the display information

To choose which information is shown on the display, go to the Power menu and tap ②, then tap №.

#### Digital clock

Show or hide the digital clock.



#### Day of the week

Show or hide the day of the week.



#### Analogue clock

Show or hide the analogue clock.



#### Date

Show or hide the date.



#### Part of the day

Show or hide the part of the day, like morning or evening. The day intervals are set in Day and Night, see *Change the settings* on page 9.



#### Day plan

Show or hide the Day plan with today's activities.



#### Calendar

Show or hide the Calendar button, see *Manage the calendar* on page 11.

TIP: When you reduce the amount of information on the display, CARY Base becomes even simpler and clearer.

## Manage the calendar

NARNING: Do not use CARY Base as the sole support for medication, medical treatment or other important activities.

#### **Update the Calendar view**

To update the Calendar, go to the Power menu. Tap 
and then tap , or tap the Calendar button in the Main view (if available).

Here all activities are listed in chronological order per day. Past activities are crossed out in the list.





#### Select day

Tap on a day to see its activities



#### Previous week

Go to the previous week.



#### Next week

Go to the next week.



#### Day plan

Indicates if the activity is shown in the Day plan.



#### Add activity


See Add an activity on the next page.

To change or delete an activity, see Edit or delete an activity on page 13.

TIP: Limit the number of activities in the Day plan to highlight activities of high importance to the user.

#### Add an activity

To add an activity, go to Calendar, see Go to the Power menu on page 8.



**Name** The name that is shown in the Day plan. Keep it descriptive and short. **Description** Additional information that in shown in the reminder.



#### Date

The date of the activity.



#### Time

The time the activity starts.



#### Recurrence

If and how the activity is repeated.

**EXAMPLE:** Walking the dog daily or birthdays once a year.



#### Show in Day plan

If an activity is shown in today's Day plan or only as a reminder.



#### Play text at alarm

The name and description are read out loud when the reminder starts.



#### Record message

The message plays when the reminder starts. This is not possible when Play text is on.




## Add picture

Choose a picture from the library to visualise the activity. To use your own pictures, see *Remote* support through myAbilia on page 13.

#### Edit or delete an activity

To edit or delete an activity, go to Calendar, see *Go to the Power menu* on page 8. Tap the activity that you want to edit or delete.





#### Change

Change the current picture.



## Delete activity

Delete the activity.



#### Remove

Remove the current picture.

#### Remote support through myAbilia

With myAbilia you can update the Calendar remotely and add pictures to the picture library.



To set up the connection between CARY Base and myAbilia, go to the Power menu, tap ② and then tap ③. Follow the instructions that are shown on the display.

If you do not have a myAbilia user account, you can create one at myabilia.com. You need an email address for this.

## **Connect external equipment**

MARNING: Only use CE marked equipment.

The following external equipment can be connected to CARY Base:

- Control switch Used instead of tapping the screen. For example, to get voice support or to turn off reminders. Connect the control switch to the socket.
- Equipment for forwarding a reminder signal For example, a vibration alert or indicator light. Connect the equipment

## **Maintenance**

## Check for new program versions

- 1. Go to the Power menu.
- 2. Tap 💽.
- 3. Tap (i).
- 4. Tap Check for updates.
- 5. If there is a new version, tap Upgrade.

## **Restore CARY Base to factory settings**

You may need to restore CARY Base when refurbishing the product or when troubleshooting problems. Restoring to factory settings removes all settings and personal information.

- 1. Go to the Power menu.
- 2. Tap 💽.
- **3.** Tap (i).
- 4. Tap Factory reset.

## **Clean CARY Base**

MARNING: Do not submerge CARY Base in water.

Clean CARY Base with a slightly damp cloth with mild detergent.

CARY Base can be cleaned with alcohol.

## Storage and disposal

Keep the product indoors at room temperature and away from moist.

**NOTE:** Switch off CARY Base before removing the power cable.

To switch off CARY Base, go to the Power menu and tap 🖒.

CARY Base keeps the settings for about one year. If CARY Base is stored for a longer time, the settings must be redone.
